- Adhere to the rules outlined in the Careful Campus Policy, Team Member Statement of Responsibility, and Corner of Love's Privacy Policy found in this contract.
- Prepare yourself for each day by packing your own backpack, water bottle, and personal items needed.
- Clean drinking water (purified and in water dispensers) will always be available. It is your responsibility to drink enough fluids.
- Only eat and drink foods and beverages offered or approved by Corner of Love team leaders.
- Only travel or ride in vehicles provided or approved by Corner of Love team leaders.
- Avoid dangerous situations and use common sense while working in Costa Rica.
- Do not practice medicine or dentistry or provide services of any kind at locations other than those indicated by team leaders.
- Do not count or show money on the street. Carry only what is needed and try to count inside a vehicle or residence.
- Do not wander from the group. Stay with team leaders and always find someone to accompany you when it is necessary to be in a separate area.
- Remain flexible and joy-filled while serving with others as part of Corner of Love Ministries.

CAREFUL CAMPUS POLICYFor all teams serving in Costa Rica



Working in a Latin American country requires a commitment to vigilance and flexibility. As your leaders, we are responsible for keeping you safe and staying abreast of societal and political changes that could affect our team's safety.

La Cruz, Costa Rica is known as a safe, close-to-border city, but recent large migrations of refugees from Nicaragua and elsewhere give us reason to point out certain "do's" and "don'ts" to our teams.

DO

- -Take an early morning beach walk, making certain to return in time to leave for the Refugee Center. This may mean walking at approximately 6-7AM.
- -Take an evening walk to see the sunset, but always leave early enough to return before dark OR ask Nelson for someone to accompany you with Corner of Love's vehicle. Ideal walking time is 4:30-5:30PM.
- Walk around the city of La Cruz when free time is available while serving at the Relief Center for Refugees.
- Familiarize yourself upon arriving at the Recreo neighborhood property.

DON'T

- Go onto property owned by others, even if invited.
- Push time limits or end up somewhere after dark. Always give yourself enough time to return to the Team House or Relief Center before sun goes down.
- Use taxi's or buses. Corner of Love teams should not explore beyond places you can walk to.
- Accept invitations to dine, walk with, or travel with locals unless okay'd by Team Leaders.
